"We, the Finger Lakes Toy Library (FLTL), believe that every child's experience should be valued, seen, and supported. As the only toy library in the Finger Lakes region, we prioritize equal access to a collection of over 1700 high-quality toys through a "pay what you can afford" membership that is decided by each member, with many members paying nothing at all. Member families and member organizations can borrow toys for up to four weeks at a time and tailor their toy choices to their specific needs and interests. While access to toys may seem less important on Maslow's hierarchy of needs, we know that for children, play is how they make sense of the world, gain confidence, and build attachment to others"

Waxing Salon, is approaching the two-year anniversary of the loan she took out from AE to grow her fledging business. "The reason why I wanted to start a business is basically for women like me, and also men kinda like me as well," Tijuanna says. "I'm a mom and a woman of color, and sometimes our opportunity's a little limited. So, I just want to have a safe space for everyone here to be able to thrive and grow along with me."

Tijuanna came to AE in a pinch: she had just launched her business in Ithaca Collegetown and was behind on rent. Being the mother of a toddler and living an hour away presented substantial challenges...The loan committee approved a \$20,000 loan with a requirement that she come to business counseling twice a month for six months. Since that time, Tijuanna has gradually grown her business from being solely dedicated to waxing services to including several hair stylists, enabling her to diversify her revenue streams and achieve more growth.



"Two years ago, my world fell apart. After being a stayat-home mom for 29 years, I left a financially abusive marriage. I had no work experience, no credit score, and no idea how to even begin rebuilding my life. Walking into the Women's Opportunity Center was terrifying. I didn't know who I was or what I wanted. My coach became more than just someone helping me find a job. She was a patient listener, a cheerleader, and a coach who pushed me to see my own value. At first, I took a cleaning job – it was all I knew. But I was challenged by my coach to think bigger. She encouraged me to take computer classes, enroll in training at SUNY EOC, and practice interview skills. I landed a job with a local school district! Through it all, my coach was there. The WOC gave me the confidence and tools to become independent and build a life I can be proud of. Today, I'm not just a survivor, I'm a thriver. Thank you, WOC!"


